

CUC Summer Program 2023

1. Period

- 10 days from Thursday, August 17 to Saturday August 26, 2023

2. Participation requirements

- Participants have completed the third round of vaccinations recognized as valid in Japan.

3. Number of Participants

- Maximum of two students from each university.
- * One male and one female due to our accommodation. They will share an apartment with another student of the same sex from a different university.
- Students who have already participated in the CUC Summer Program before are not eligible to apply to this program.

4. Minimum number of participants

- 10 (Program may be cancelled if the number of applicants is less than the minimum)

5. Provided by CUC

- Lectures, Activities, Accommodation, Meals (except on weekends)

6. To be paid by the participant

- Airfare, non-program meals, and free time activities
- Travel insurance, round-trip transportation from airport to accommodation

*If the program is cancelled, participants are responsible for cancellation fees for airline tickets, etc.

7. Accommodation

- During the program, participants will stay in the International dormitory or the guest house on campus.

- You may check into the dormitory on Thursday, August 17 after 16:00. If you come to Japan before the check-in date and time, you are asked to book your own hotel.
- Check-out is on Saturday, August 26 at 10 am

9. Overseas travel insurance

All participants must buy their traveler's insurance which covers the duration of the trip, from the departure date to the date of return to their home country. CUC will ask participants to submit the PDF files of their insurance copy before the start of the program.
